I ("Student") hereby register for the above-indicated course offered by the Alliance Française Institut ("AFI"). I understand that although membership in the Alliance Française Chapitre de Grasse ("Chapter") is not a condition of enrollment, Chapter membership privileges include tuition discounts, mailings with news of Chapter events, and opportunities for language practice, as well as special member pricing for events. I have read and understood the AFI refund policy (below), and I accept its terms.

Registration policy: Fees for AFI courses are indicated in each session's course description flyer and are subject to change without notice. Payment must be made in full at the time of registration. Student may transfer to a different level during the course of a session without penalty. Any class cancelled by AFI for any reason will be rescheduled or a full tuition refund will be issued. In order to guarantee consistency, all course manuals must be purchased from AFI.

Refund policy: In view of the Chapter's not-for-profit status, its commitment to keeping tuition costs affordable, and its responsibility to its teachers, cash refunds will not be issued. However, Student may withdraw from class at any time until the end of the first week of class and receive a partial tuition credit. In the event that Student wishes to withdraw from the class, the following conditions must be met:

- Student must notify the AFI Director in writing of the intent to withdraw.
- Notice must be received by the AFI Director prior to the day of the second scheduled class.
- Student will receive a credit for the amount of tuition, less an administrative fee of \$30. The credit may be applied toward the tuition for a future AFI class and is valid for a period of one year from the date issued.
- No cash refunds will be made.
- No credit will be issued after the first week of class.
